#### **Irish Setter**

- **PG** (1) Allum's Macarica Street Dancer. Presented in good condition this b stood over her ground and presented a balanced outline. On the go around she was very much at one with her handler displaying a happy and confident disposition. Good presentation and better side gait clinched her BoB over the open winner.
- **O** (2) 1 Fox's Satlas Bleau Eyes. Tidy type of bitch, sweet head and correct ear set. Not showing to advantage today as not firing on all cylinders. Did enough to win this class but had to give way to the enthusiastic younger competitor for higher honours. 2 Fox's Settaside Jelly Bean.

#### **Pointer**

- J (7,2) Good class 1 Watkins & Davies' Hurwyn Law N Order. Smart, upstanding b & w who presented a typical outline. Grand head, neck and shoulders. Excellent topline, croup and tailset. Well angled fore and aft and presented in great nick. Moved out very well, in tune with handler and covering plenty of ground with lots of drive using his construction to his advantage, RBOB. 2 Isherwood's Symitry Tickled Pink, a smart, well made young lady full of mischief but a very worthy BP. 3 Davis' Wilchrimane Xcel.
- **PG** (2) 1 Rankine's Jilony Heaven Can Wait For Fyldefair JW ShCM. Tidy b of a useful sort. Nice type of head, good neck and front assembly. Strong over the topline and croup. Well angled and muscled quarters enabled a good action going around. 2 Davis' Wilchrimane Xcel.
- **O** (5) 1 Woods' Wilchrimane Let's Dance at Penbro. Very feminine b&w who presented a balanced outline. Totally sound and so well made all through, she impressed for overall balance stacked and on the move. Reachy neck, well laid shoulder and she possesses a useful return of upper arm. Plenty heart and lung room. Well ribbed back to short loin, leading to strong croup and well set on tail. Low hocks enabled a strong driving action which was offset by plenty of reach from the forequarters. Totally at one with her accomplished handler and presented in first class order totally fit for function and this clinched her BoB, and later Group 1 & RBIS.

### **Retriever (Labrador)**

- J (2) 1 Stafford's Sandilands Blissful Farnfield. Was really taken with this b, totally brand new, fresh and absolutely up for it. Has attitude, presence and style coupled with great type. Correct head and expression. Strong neck and well balanced angulation fore and aft. On the go around she already covers plenty of ground with a sound athletic action. Time will see her firm up and tighten all through, a bright future is sure to follow, BoB & BP. 2 Mills' Linjor Magnolia at Jaybec.
- **PG** (5) 1 Hoban's Meadowleigh Romantica. Headed what turned out to be a difficult class as some where very pleasing stacked but let themselves down on the move, whilst others moved well but lacked essential breed attributes. This black b did enough to win this class with her typical outline, plenty of substance and correct head. Moved out well enough to take RBoB. 2 Davies' Lembas Candy Girl at Holmajor. 3 Mills' Lembas Thank U For The Music at Jaybec.
- **O** (1) Hoban's Meadowleigh Morella. Well made b possessing a typical outline. Strong neck and well bodied with correct ribbing. Moved out tidily but had to give way to the veracity of younger competition today.

## **Spaniel (American Cocker)**

**PG** (3) 1 Niessen's Moonmist Cats Miaow. Smart d, good type and nice outline. Good head, eye and ears. Strong neck, well ribbed and strong topline. Very well angled hindquarters which he used to advantage on the move. Presented and handled well. 2 Hobbins' Norrasha River Phoenix. **O** (3) 1 Abbott's Afterglow Jackie Oh It's Janost. Fabulous young b presented in great condition. Sweet feminine head, good eye size and shape. Reachy neck to well laid shoulders and possesses a good return of upper arm to compliment. Well developed in brisket and ribbing which lead well back. Strong topline and croup, well muscled and angled quarters. On the move she was glorious, reaching out, covering the ground with ease whilst powering along with a strong driving action. Clear BoB. 2 Niessen's Embercourt Starshine. 3 Lucyzynski's Fecimus Pink Petticoat at Kanara.
